PLACEMENT OF SIGNS

The Village of Mukwonago has sign ordinances regarding the placement of signs. They are as follows:

- Signs should be on private property
- No signs are allowed in the public right-of-way
- The property owner should have granted you permission for the placement of a sign on their property
- Sign should not be lighted
- Sign should maintain the vision clearance at intersections.
- Signs may not exceed 12 square feet in area in residential districts and 32 square feet in area in all other districts, except in the case where such signs are permitted by state statute.
- Signs shall not be erected prior to the first day of the "election campaign period" as defined in W.S.A., ch. 12.04. Signs shall be removed within five days following the election.
- On election day, no sign may be placed within 100 feet of the entrance to the polling place
