

Village Tax Rate Updates

The Village Tax Rate only represents roughly 35% of the total property tax bill.

The total Village Property Tax Levy for all the Village purposes is \$6,671,835.75. (including Tax Increment Financing Increments)

The total equalized value for 2019 is \$926,137,500 which is an increase of 3.34%.

Lottery and Gaming Credit

You may claim a lottery and gaming credit on one tax parcel in the State of Wisconsin if you were the owner of the described property on January 1, 2019 and used it as your primary residence for the year.

If you qualify, you should already see a Lottery and Gaming credit for this parcel on your tax bill. If you qualify, but did not receive the credit on your tax bill, we can make that adjustment for you.

First Dollar Credit

You do not need to apply for the First Dollar Credit. The credit is calculated on the total equalized value of the parcel for both land and improvement values. **The credit** is funded from **the state** general fund.

The first dollar credit is paid on any real estate parcel with at least one improvement.

The credit equals **the** school property tax on a certain amount (**the credit** value) of **the** market value of a qualifying real estate parcel

Enclosed is your 2019 Village of Mukwonago real estate tax statement. The tax statement is mailed to the owner of the property on record as of October 31, 2019. If there are any questions, please call (262) 363-6421.

Your real estate tax statement may be paid in full or in three installments.

First installment is due by **January 31**

Second installment is due **April 30**

Final installment is due **July 31**

If any installment is not paid by the due date, the **entire** balance of the tax bill becomes delinquent with interest retroactive to February 1st.

Please note the Village no longer has a PO Box. If you set up auto payments to be mailed from your bank, you may want to verify the correct address has been entered. Payments made by mail, must be postmarked by the post office on or before the due date to be considered timely

Village Hall Drop Box

The payment drop box is located in the Northwest corner of the Village Hall parking lot. Place all payments in an envelope. No cash is allowed in the payment drop box.

In-Person at Village Hall

Office hours: Monday - Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Fridays, 8:00 a.m. to noon. **Village Hall will not be open New Year's Eve.** If you wish to pay your taxes by December 31, you may pay at selected bank branches as described. The Village Hall is closed on December 24, 25, 31, and January 1.

Online Payments

Payment by credit and debit cards are being accepted for property taxes at www.villageofmukwonago.com and click on "Make A Payment" button. Residents will need to include Name, Email, Parcel ID, address, and amount due.

Note: There is a convenience fee (currently 3.25% for credit/debit cards and \$2.95 for electronic checks)

TAX PAYMENTS MUST BE MADE SEPARATE FROM ANIMAL LICENSES OR UTILITY PAYMENTS

Dog & Cat Licensing

Under Chapter 14 of the Village Municipal Code, the owner of any dog and/or cat must obtain a license. Dog/Cat License Applications are available on the Village website (www.villageofmukwonago.com) under Forms & Applications or in-person at Village Clerk's Office. **A current rabies certificate and proof of distemper vaccination from your veterinarian IS REQUIRED** when applying for the license. License fees vary depending on the County you reside in. Please log online to review the application.

If you wish to have the license mailed back to you, a **self-addressed-stamped-envelope IS REQUIRED.** A late fee of \$5.00 will be charged if the license is applied after **March 31.**
